- The meeting made no decision regarding what trophies or prizes (other than the perpetual trophies) should be awarded to players and agreed to raise the issue at the AGM, however noted the importance of recognising lower rated players in some way, eg by a "Reserve" or ratings prizes. In the meantime, <u>Stephen agreed to price trophies/medallions</u>.
