President's Report

Other Business

- **Equipment**

Curtis Perry enquired whether there was a chance of storing the equipment at the Hellenic Club. This was asked previously two years ago, and there have not been any further updates. If it were to become possible, the club could purchase a lockable box. Roy/ Peter to enquire about this with Hellenic Club. The hiring of a P.O. box was raised as another alternative to transporting the equipment every week.

- **Game Rules**

- **Tournaments**

Peter Johnston raised the issue of running a tournament as FIDE rated. It was mentioned that there are administrative requirements, and a slightly higher cost. An informal vote showed that a considerable majority of members would be interested in participating.

The possibility of running a rapid tournament as *Fischer Random* was also discussed. According to the informal vote, most members would **not** wish to participate in such a 3-week tournament. There was interest for a one-week blitz tournament, if this could be fitted into the calendar.
